Dear Parishioners.

By a quirk of providence, the 2nd reading from 7th June right through to the 13th September takes us through the majority of the book of Romans. It's been said that if the New Testament were the Himalayas, Romans would be Mount Everest.

'Paul's letter to Rome is the high peak of scripture, all roads in the bible lead to Romans, and all views afforded by the bible are clearly seen from Romans.' - J. I. Packer.

If you've ever read this letter you will understand my train of thought, but not necessarily the book. For those of us who have been on the road a long time or those just starting the journey. This season we embark upon is a real opportunity for us to wrestle with one of the most profound books in scripture.

So I invite you to come and climb this mountain with me, bring your walking boots, a good pair of socks and a handkerchief. We will begin our journey on 31st May, then spending each Sunday, chapter by chapter until the 13th September.

Each week from the 7th June till 13th August we will listen to a series of 10 videos from the Bible Society about the book of Romans, on Sunday or Tuesday or Thursday evenings, (see Calendar), giving us 3 opportunities in the week to engage with the material, if you can't do one session you've got another two opportunities

There will be notes, maps and plans to help us understand our journey. I am convinced if we can commit to this it will change our lives and our relationship with God in a deep and loving way.
